Certain materials do exist that vermin could gnaw or tear through and penetrate. Therefore, a piece of equipment that is fabricated correctly could still be penetrated by vermin if certain materials that it was fabricated from were not adequate. I will admit that this requirement in the materials section is not used very often, but do believe it has value and I do not feel comfortable removing it.

However, I feel that even though the Design and construction section allows for insulation, the Materials section does not. I suggest the following revision to Section 4 Materials:

The requirements contained in this section are intended to ensure that the materials used in the manufacture of warewashing machines resist wear and penetration by vermin (insulation in sealed enclosures is exempt) and are unaffected by detergents, sanitizers, and other substances present in the intended use environment.

I suggest adding the last sentence (taken from NSF/ANSI 2, Section 4 Materials) to NSF/ANSI 3 – Commercial warewashing equipment (3i7r1e) Section 4 Materials:

The requirements contained in this section are intended to ensure that the materials used in the manufacture of warewashing machines resist wear and penetration by vermin and are unaffected by detergents, sanitizers, and other substances present in the intended use environment. ADD: Materials used in unexposed non-food zone areas shall be exempt from all requirements in 4.
