B. Chlorine terminology (DWA-61-2014-2)

<u>Motion:</u> R. Sakaji motioned to ballot the proposed language as written. M. Morrison seconded the motion.

<u>Discussion:</u> P. Greiner suggested that NSF/ANSI 61 be clarified throughout the document to state that "free available chlorine" is used in the exposure water as opposed to simply "chlorine." There was no further discussion.
