2. Scope: Question was asked. Do we share a common definition of what constitutes an Economic item? Group discussed and decided to use the GRI definition for Economic as a starting point for language.

Using the current the GRI definition to start

GRI Definition:

The economic dimension of sustainability reporting concerns the organization's impacts on the economic conditions of its stakeholders and on economic systems at local, national and global levels. GRS's Economic indicators illustrate:

- *Flow of capital among different stakeholders; and*
- *Main economic impacts of the organization throughout society*

Strategy:

1. Define the definition and boundaries of “Economic”
2. Determine specific KPIs/create a list table of contents with categories
3. Begin to write criteria around each category.

Review of Material Topics

- QUESTION: Should the integration group look at the definition of “Stakeholders”? Identifying stakeholders and if the stakeholders are the same across the board of Env, Econ and Soc or should it be identified separately.
- There are differing views about whether shareholder interests are relevant for the NSF 391.1 standard – we will need to discuss more fully.
- We will also likely face some overlap between Social and Economic indicators (e.g. where does philanthropy or community development fall?)

- We should be mindful about the difference between raw giving and the impact and measurements of those gifts.
