Requirements for an “Instruction Plate”

Brief statement of information provided:

Many of the NSF Standards have requirements for an “Instruction Plate” be placed on a piece of equipment that provides the manufacturers recommended cleaning and sanitization procedures and their frequency. As new technology is developed these instruction are documented in Menu Driven Software which would eliminate the need to have an instruction plate on the unit. Since this type of requirement is in a number of NSF Standards I would like to add this topic for a brief discussion to get the opinion of other task group chairs to see what their opinion is.

NSF STD 6, Clause 5.29 “Instruction plate” is the type of requirement I am referring to in the above statement.
