#### **Purpose**

The proposed revision will update registration requirements to include products.

### **Background**

Congress passed the Modernization of Cosmetics Regulations Act in December 2022. By this year's end (2023) products sold in the US will require registration and listing. This issue proposes to keep the standard and ARG in compliance with US law, while retaining the wording "where required" to ensure the standard remains useful internationally where product listing may not be required.

# Good Manufacturing Practices for Cosmetics

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## 4 Audit requirements

### 4.1 Context of the organization

- **4.1.1** Manufacturers, packers, and distributors of cosmetic products that are in commercial distribution shall be registered with the regulatory agency in the country of manufacture or sale, if required by the relevant jurisdiction(s).
- **4.1.2** Where manufacturers, packers, and distributors of cosmetic products that are in commercial distribution are the responsibly party, those products shall be registered with the regulatory agency in the country of manufacture or sale, as required by the relevant jurisdiction(s).
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
